

The City of Whittier is developing and implementing a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) pursuant to State Water Resources Control Board Order 2006-0003, Statewide General Discharge Requirements of Sanitary Sewer Systems. The goal of the SSMP is to minimize the frequency and severity of sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs). The SSMP will cover the management, planning, design, and operation and maintenance of the agency's sanitary sewer system. The development process began during May 2008 and it is expected to be complete during 2009. The duration of the implementation is unknown at this time.
